UNODC: HIV/AIDS Grants for Civil Society Organizations

The United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) is currently seeking proposals for its HIV/AIDS Grants programme to provide funding support to Civil Society Organisations (CSOs) including Community Based Organisations (CBOs) working in the area of HIV prevention, treatment, care and support among people who inject drugs and people in prisons whose projects are aimed at building capacity of national partners.

Deadline: 20 March 2017

Maximum budget: 30,000 USD

Community-based organisations are particularly encouraged to apply as the Call is aimed at helping to ensure that people who use drugs and people in prison will receive higher quality HIV services that are better tailored to their needs.

The Grant funding under this Call for Proposals shall be provided under the following categories:

Category 1: Building capacity of the civil society organizations, in particular community-based organisations, in implementation of HIV services and programs

Category 2: Building capacity of the civil society organizations, in particular community-based organisations, in results-based program management and leadership

Category 3: Building capacity of the civil society organizations, in particular community-based organisations, in developing sustainable partnerships with government stakeholders and local partners
