The Aids Fonds is seeking applications for its 2016 small grants program primarily concerning HIV/AIDS related issues.

The small grant budget is reserved for short innovative and promising projects with a budget up to \in 10,000.

Funding will only be provided to registered organisations with a strong track record.

Prime Recipients for Key Populations Investment Fund (KPIF)

Closing Date for Applications: 11:59pm EDT, Oct 21, 2016 **Eligible EECA countries:** Kazakhstan, Kyrgyz Republic, Tajikistan, Ukraine

S/GAC encourages organizations led by individuals representing KP communities or with long histories of promoting KP leadership to apply. Prime Recipients may request **\$500,000 to \$10,000,000** over a four-year period. The UNAIDS conducted 2 information conference calls with Q and A sessions about the opportunity. Research grant opportunity: Sustained Release of Antivirals for Treatment or Prevention of HIV

The purpose of this Funding Opportunity Announcement is to encourage grant applications that address the long term goal and objective of developing sustained release strategies for HIV treatment or prevention. The goal of developing safe, effective and well-tolerated acceptable sustained release formulations/regimens is thus to improve adherence by significantly simplifying dosing requirements while maintaining consistent and effective drug levels in plasma and HIV target tissues.

Application due dates: January 4, 2017; January 4, 2018; January 4, 2019, by 5:00 PM local time of applicant organization.

Application **budgets are not limited** but need to reflect the actual needs of the proposed project.

The maximum project period is 5 years.
