




Funding Request submissions & registrations, by TRP window

144 country and multi-country allocation funding requests will be reviewed in 2020, with another 61 expected in 2021.

TRP Review Window 1

In the first TRP review window:

- 45 funding requests have been submitted for 30 countries and 1 multi-country
- Requests consist of:
 - \$4.7 billion of <u>allocation</u> funds
 - \$129 million of matching funds
 - \$120 million of multi-country funds (RAI only)
 - \$2.3 billion of prioritized above-allocation request

Window 1: Unique in many ways

- First TRP window in the 2020-2022 cycle following a successful 6th replenishment: Responsibility of ensuring higher country allocations are invested to ensure countries are on track to end the epidemics
- A completely remote TRP meeting: TRP has demonstrated ability to adapt and innovate to deliver its
 mandate while maintaining quality
- First on-boarding of new TRP members recruited in 2019: 39 of the 84 new members recruited in 2019 have been called to serve
- Former TRP members also mobilized to address need for experienced reviewers in virtual groups:
 26 former members have supported W1 reviews, in line with TRP terms of reference. In total 118 TRP reviewers for W1
- Parallel Panels: 5 panels of reviews are running simultaneously, to address the extended time required to review each funding request remotely (with reviewers in different time zones), and compensate for COVID-19 related responsibilities many TRP members have in their home countries

How the TRP has responded to applicant disruption due to COVID-19

- Doubled the TRP windows in 2020: monthly submissions until end August to allow
 CCMs to submit each component when ready and as early as possible
- TRP will review remotely in smaller panels and finalize form within 8 weeks from submission
- TRP will consider level of in-country disruption when finalizing review form recommendations
